## Russian piano prodigy Daria Korotkova

Colorado State University School of the Arts' Prodigy and Protégé Series presents Daria Korotkova, a young Russian piano prodigy, on Saturday, Jan. 23, 7:30 p.m. in the Griffin Concert Hall at the University Center for the Arts, 1400 Remington Street.

### 'Incredible talent'

Daria "Dasha" Korotkova, a 14-year old pianist from St. Petersburg, has a dream to come to the U.S. to study piano and eventually become an artist on the international concert stage.

"Dasha's incredible talent was brought to my attention in 2008 through DVDs of her performances at an International Music Festival in Germany," said Janet Landreth, coordinator of keyboard studies at CSU. "I was stunned at the technical and musical genius of this young prodigy, who at the age of 12 was playing five or six Chopin Etudes, the Bach Chromatic Fantasy and Fugue, and other works of extreme difficulty."

Daria Korotkova, accompanied by her mother, will spend several weeks in the U.S. for a series of lessons and concerts; at her University Center for the Arts concert she performs Sergei Rachmaninov's *Six Moments Musicaux, Opus 16*, Frédéric Chopin's *Sonata No. 2 in B-flat minor, Op. 35*, and Alexander Scriabin's *Five Etudes, Op. 8*.
